HISTORICAL NOTE

GRID LEAK - A high resistance placed in the grid circuit of a vacuum tube to permit the electrons forming the grid current to leak off after each charge, thus preventing their accumulating on the grid in such numbers as to stop the flow from the filament.

For experimental work a fairly satisfactory grid leak can be made by the simple expedient of drawing a line on a piece of cardboard with a soft pencil - the graphite mark acting as the resistance. At each end of the cardboard is placed a binding post in contact with the graphite, each binding post being connected to opposite sides of the grid condenser.

VERMONT SECTION NEWS

The editorial staff of QST is now enforcing the Vermont Section News column limit of 21 lines! I can touch the highlights in QST, but details have to be carried in other articles such as this one. We are trying to get more room, but alas, that means taking advertising space which pays the bills!

VERMONT HAMSI!

According to my database, Vermont now has 1651 licensed Amateur Radio operators which makes us the FIFTH RAREST state, just behind WY, DE, ND, and SD. According to W5YI Report, our growth rate over the last 5 years is 46%, the SIXTH fastest growth rate in the U.S., and the fastest growth rate in the entire Northeast! The average U.S. Ham growth rate is around 35%. Presently, there are over 500 VT members of the ARRL, or 32% of the Amateur population. Believe it or not, this is the FOURTH best percentage, just behind NJ, CT (no surprise!) and NH. In summary, we have been very good in promoting the Amateur Service and supporting our National Organization. Let's continue to keep up the great work!

NEW ENGLAND CABINET MEETING

The Division Cabinet meeting was held recently with ARRL field officials present from all over New England. One of the key topics of discussion was how to better integrate new Technicians into Amateur Radio and ARRL operating activities. ARRL membership amongst Technicians is quite low. As the ARRL is supposed to represent ALL amateur operators, this is a situation which is not good, particularly in light of the fact that the Technician class is the fastest growing group of Amateurs. Lots of ideas were discussed but nothing concrete was decided. QST now includes a section

dedicated to newer Amateurs with articles which are much easier to read. What are your ideas on the subject? What should the ARRL change to better serve your needs as an Amateur operator? Please let me know by phone or letter.

THE LONG WAIT!

The long delays in receiving licenses from the FCC has everyone frustrated. The FCC Gettysburg office had personnel out sick and on vacation and got behind in processing licenses. They have put in some temporary measures to catch up and plan to get back to normal processing time (whatever that is!) shortly.

VERMONT NEWS

I am encouraging our section level staff to take more responsibility in managing the various areas of the field organization. The section staff handles Emergency Preparedness, Traffic Management, Club Affairs, Public Information, Government Liaison and Education. These areas were represented with forums at the Milton Hamfest and I hope you checked them out. I also plan to have a section wide meeting with the field staff and officials from each of the clubs sometime in the future. Speaking of clubs, we are now up to 11 full ARRL affiliated clubs, with the addition of the Southern VT ARC and the Brattleboro ARC. This is a 100% increase in Amateur Radio clubs since 1990, a fairly hefty growth rate! Last year we spoke of organizing a Council of Radio Clubs in Vermont to aid each other and plan joint activities. I have given our Affiliated Club Coordinator, WA1ITZ, the task of making this a reality this year. Again, any ideas you have to make this work would be most appreciated!
