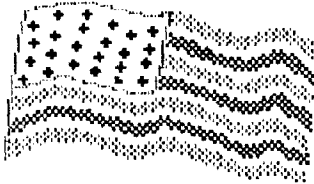
### 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF CVFMA

The revised Constitution and Bylaws will be put to a vote at the October general membership business meeting which will be held in the Community Room of the Sugar River Savings Bank in Newport NH, on October 22. The meeting will be held following the traditional pot luck luncheon which starts at noon. This will be followed by the election of officers for the coming year.

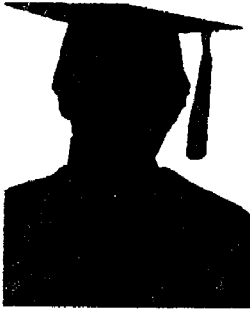
